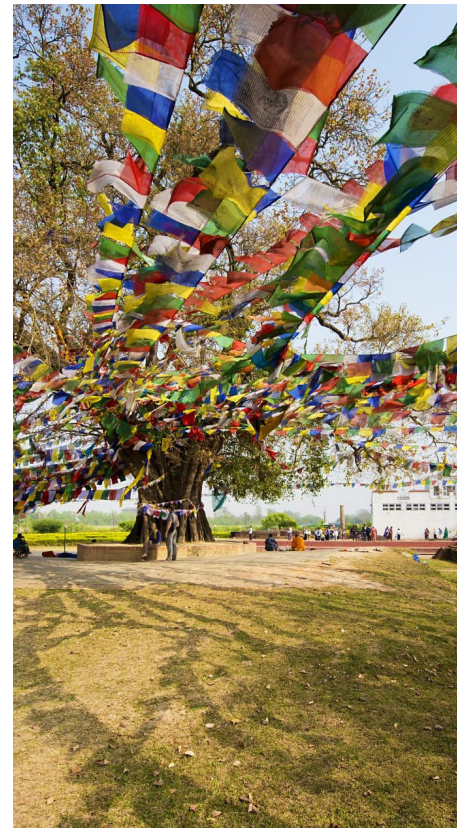

CONTEXT

Bougha Gumha Magar Homestay: Conservation and Sustainable, development of Tourism: Gumba Village is a naturally and culturally rich place, attractive for community-based tourism but they have different problem of garbage and rubbish is commonly found in this village without proper waste management. Business and employment opportunities are high but environmental issues are representing big challenges in this society related to hosting and attracting more tourists in the area.

The strategy is to expand business and employment opportunities for the economically disadvantaged people, providing training so that they are in a position to take up these opportunities, increase the income of individual earners and spread awareness program about cultural/ environmental preservation and promotion to the wider community

PURPOSE OF YOUR CBT VOLUNTEERING PROJECT:

The project seeks to facilitate and improve waste management, reduce environmental pollution, increase recycling and cleanliness of the area while generating employment opportunities.

You will be involved in the work with Magar people related to the improvement of the garbage management, the environmental protection and recycling and developing initiatives within the community that can generate income for them. You will have the chance to develop and hold educational or practical workshops, take part or lead community meetings that supports this goal.

INTERCULTURAL EXPERIENCE YOU WILL BE PART OF:

- Learning traditional recipes, and preparation of meals together with the family
- Introducing the family and community people to various aspects of your culture and traditions
- Family gardening, and production of home-grown vegetables, fruits, grains and herbs.
- Traditional dances typical of the Magar community
